*\*Please note that the lead presenter must be actively certified as a BCBA OR hold a doctorate and have completed substantial, formal training in behavior analysis OR be a graduate student enrolled in a behavior-analytic doctoral program who has received a master's degree. The lead presenter must also have expertise in the subject matter of the presentation and agree to follow the BACB Ethics Code throughout the presentation.*

-Name(s) & contact info for any co-presenters

*\*Co-presenters do not need to be BCBAs.*

-Abstract for presentation

-Minimum of 3 learning objectives

*\*Learning objectives must provide instruction beyond the BACB task list.*

-For presentations with Ethics or Supervision CEs, a brief justification of this CE type

-Any affiliations with companies, products, or services that may be featured during the presentation

-Datasets/Graphs

*\*If relevant to presentation type.*
